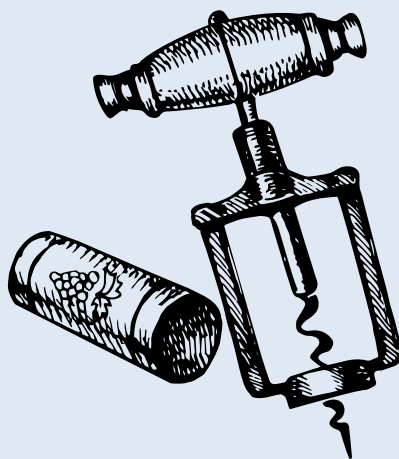

The prices stated are our Cambridge Wine Merchants wholesale prices, so we are always beating the market. To obtain these prices, we ask for a minimum spend of £250.

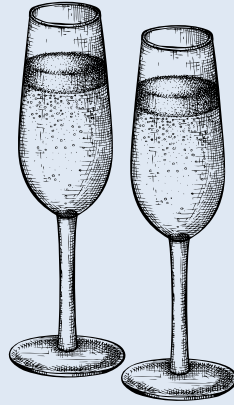
Our Best Sellers

SPARKLING WINE



Solealto Spumante Extra Dry: £7.62

Fully sparkling, lightly fruity and properly dry. Clean and fresh on the palate. Huge seller.

Le Calle Prosecco Spumante DOC Extra Dry: £9.42

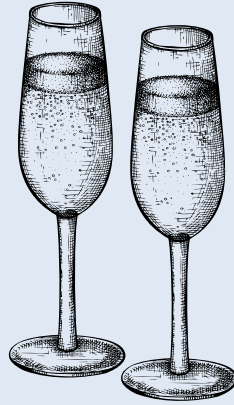
A brightly fruity Prosecco giving tropical pineapple, pear, and vibrant apple notes. This is not an austere, dry wine; it is a delightful sparkling wine for any party.

Antech Blanquette de Limoux Tradition Brut NV: £12.12

Limoux is the world's original birthplace of sparkling wine, with the first bubbles produced here in the year 1544, some 150 years before

Dom Perignon began making sparkling wine in Champagne. Winemaker Francoise Antech is third generation of women running the company. Jancis Robinson: "Good Value. Refreshing...Super clean and long."

SPARKLING WINE



Jansz Premium Cuvée NV Brut Tasmania: £18.12

Seriously up there with the best of Champagne: yeasty and buttery, cracking value. Fruit grown on selected, cool climate vineyards across Tasmania to maximize blending options and complexity in the final wine, batches are kept separate during winemaking. Secondary fermentation takes place in the bottle and is aged on yeast lees for as long as possible. The average age of the final blend is around two years Honeysuckle and citrus scents are immediately apparent Slight aromas of nougat, roasted nuts and a hint of strawberry from the Pinot Noir. Delicate fruits and creaminess fills the mouth with a lingering finish of citrus and nougat.

WHITE WINE



Cal y Canto Verdejo 2021 Tierra de Castilla: £6.72

A classic Spanish white – 100% Verdejo Temperature controlled fermentation preserves the fresh lemon and melon fruit; fruity but fresh great value. Great with seafood, and a lovely summer drinker.

Ai Galera Mistico, Portugal: £8.28

Another winner from indigenous varieties; Portugal's great vinous inheritance. Demonstrates the skill and style of Portuguese winemaking these days, and the value of their offering. No oak, no over-extraction, no-nonsense, just a beautiful limpid, light, lifted, bracing white so light it has no sign of gold in the colour if anything a slightly green hue.

V Sauvignon Blanc 2022 Marlborough: £10.38

Mouth-watering Sauvignon Blanc, with ripe tropical fruit flavours and a twist of crisp citrus.

WHITE WINE



Ch. Rives-Blanques Cuvée Odyssee Chardonnay 2021 Limoux AOC: £15.72

This domaine's showpiece wine is made using the best Chardonnay grapes, fermented and matured in French oak. Burgundian and silky in style, Odysée featured on the dream wine list of three 'Best Sommelier in the World' winners.

Chablis 2019 Dom. Fournillon: £16.26

Lovely small-estate, mineral, citrusy Chablis, just as it should be.
Crying out for seafood or just good company.

ROSE WINE



Pinot Grigio Rosé 2021 Bella Modella, Terre di Chieti IGT, Abruzzo: £7.92

This delicate Rose has deliciously strawberry-laced aromas followed by a seductive palate of crisp, juicy, creamy fruit. Ideal for sipping chilled on a summer's day or coupled with lightly spicy foods.

Dom. Gayda La Minuette Organic Rosé 2021 IGP Pays d'Oc, Cert. Organic: £11.16 90/100 Decanter Magazine

Light and softly framed, this wine shows juicy stone fruit with red fruit highlights. The palate has plenty of ripe peach and apricot, fresh cranberry and intense grapefruit pith, with a saline and succulent finish. Mourvèdre, Syrah, Grenache and Cinsault grapes are all sourced from the La Livinière area in the Minervois

ROSE WINE



Jules Cotes de Provence Rosé 2021: £12.18

The nose is refined and aromatic, with aromas of white peach and citrus fruits and a touch of minerality. The palate is fruity and crunchy with great length. A well-balanced wine, between roundness and freshness.

Miraval Rosé De Provence £20.40

The world superstar of Provence pink. Delicate, complex and pale. Rare and sought-after. Summer in a glass. This stunning 17th-century estate was bought by Angelina Jolie and Brad Pitt in 2009. After many millions spent restoring the vineyards and winery this world-class, super-pale, delicate but intensely flavoured pink became an instant classic – rated by Wine Spectator as the best rosé in the world, with early vintages sold out on release. Winemaking is by our old chum the famed Marc Perrin – whose family owns the stellar Chateauneuf-du-Pape estate Beaucastel, which has famously practised organic farming since the 1950s.

RED WINE



Cal y Canto Tempranillo Merlot Syrah 2021

Tierra de Castilla: £6.72

Rich, fruity and intense, it is loaded with raspberry and black cherry aromas, cedar chips and pretty violet notes and a hint of vanilla. The vanilla pops back again on the palate with caramel and supple grapey flavours.

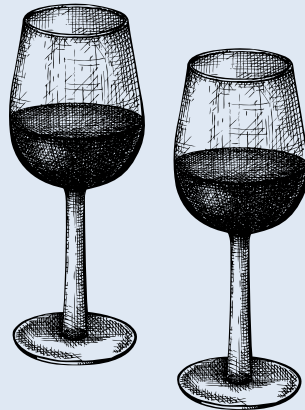
Ai Galera Poetico Tinto Tejo, Portugal: £8.28

An intense ruby-red colour. Vinous and clean aromas with hints of red berry fruits. Round in the mouth and medium-bodied. A well-rounded finish with mellow tannin.

Vin Rouge Cambridge Wine Merchants NV: £10.00

Has to be one of the best-value most impressive French red wines on the UK market. Special edition made for us by famed Chateauneuf grower Roger Sabon, the wine-maker is esteemed Didier Negrón. Charmingly honest, hearty (15%!), herbal, dense and punchy, juicy red from the classic southern varieties of Grenache, Syrah, Cinsault & friends. What a beauty, what a bargain. Although full-bodied the wine has soft tannins and a silky texture – this is the beauty of Southern Rhone reds, ready to enjoy as soon as they're made, unlike Bordeaux or Burgundy. Grenache in this hot sunny heaven gives ripe raspberry and black cherry notes and depth, Syrah gives a classic black pepper spice and dark-chocolate grip. A cool fennel/mint edge and lift.

RED WINE



Diomede Lama di Pietra Nero di Troia 2021:

£11.10

Rich and chocolatey. Smooth and quaffable. plenty of jammy black fruit and a touch of sweet spice. Organically farmed. Our biggest selling red by a mile!

Rosso del Palazzone Lotto 2021/02 Il Palazzone:

£15.24

We've shipped this wonderful 'declassified Brunello' from Il Palazzone for over a decade now. Always a treat, and an utterly delightful bargain. The wine is 100% Sangiovese Grosso, known in Montalcino as Brunello - all from the estates own Brunello di Montalcino vineyards.

Ch. La Chapelle Despagnet 2017 Saint-Emilion

Grand Cru: £16.92

From a small 7ha vineyard on the plain just below the town of Saint-Emilion, owned by the Gagnaire brothers. 80% Merlot and 20% Cabernet Franc. Bright deep ruby, with appealing aromas of plum, blackberry and vanilla. Charming body, very drinkable young, but well balanced between acidity and tannins, with lots of pretty fruit.

PORT & DESERT WINE



Smith Woodhouse Ruby Port: £12.96

Classic SWH style – dark chocolate and violets. Surely the best value Ruby Port on the market.

Monbazillac 2014 Château de Géraud: £13.14

Owned by the Gerardin family since the beginning of the 20th Century this dessert wine comes from the Monbazillac region of South West France. Similar grapes varieties and conditions to Sauternes are experienced in Monbazillac, with the development of 'noble rot' in late autumn. Old vines of 50+ years are used to make this golden aromatic dessert wine which shows botrytis aromas of smoke, marmalade and honey. A good but not very high level of residual sugar and bright acidity make for a delicious and easy-to-drink wine to match with fruit desserts, pastries and blue cheeses.
